A hackathon is a great instrument for creative problem solving that may give birth to ideas or startups and will be the kick-off event for further activities to create a cleantech ecosystem in the region. It aspires to:

- identify clean-tech and software talent in Southeast Asia and connect both
- overcome industry challenges by (starting to) develop relevant solar software
- produce ideas worth pursuing after the event e.g. with the help of the involved incubator and accelerator network (see who)
- raise awareness for SEA to solar startups (see who)
- connect talent to experienced entrepreneurs and clean-tech experts
- provide a platform for exchange

2. Community-based Renewable Energy Conference (app. Mid October)

Every year we are organizing this conference to bring all relevant stakeholders together (communities, developer, technology supplier, governmental representatives etc.) and discuss and develop ideas to enable and implement community-based projects on the ground.
