## Project Officer

The project “Support the development and implementation of Thai Climate Change Policy” is the core part of the Thai-German cooperation on climate change. The overall objective of the project is to promote the development and implementation of the climate change policy in Thailand. In the frame of the Green Climate Fund (GCF) preparatory and readiness support, GIZ also supports capacity building of the Thai National Designated Authority (NDA), the Office of Natural Resources and Environmental Policy and Planning (ONEP) with the objective of strengthening Thailand’s engagement with the Fund.

The current position will concentrate on the national level and the cooperation with the Thai partners on climate finance and climate policy development, especially on GCF preparatory and readiness. Hence, the project wishes to hire a project officer with the following responsibilities:

Responsibilities:

- Develop project work plans / strategies and monitoring of project progress
- Lead discussion with Thai political partners on GCF and all related documents and procedures
- Support the partners with expertise on issues of climate change as well as climate finance in their policy development, especially on GCF
- Contribute to workshops and conferences organization on climate change especially climate finance related issue
- Formulate and coordinate the stakeholders’ engagement and knowledge management system on climate finance issues for GIZ and project partners
- Coordinate the support of subcontractors
- Coordinate with other international projects

We are looking for a candidate who preferably possesses (the equivalent of):

- Minimally 5 years of professional working experience in a similar position, working on climate change related issues
- University degree in environment studies, finance/business management, social/political sciences or any other relevant topic
- Experience in working in or with Thai government agencies/financial institution
- Experience of project management
- Experience of working in an international context
- Understanding of players and processes in Thai as well as in international climate politics
- Excellent command of Thai and English in writing and speaking; knowledge of German is an advantage

This will be a fixed-term contract, starting as soon as possible and running until June 2018. There is a possibility of continuing beyond this date.
