GIZ has a record of more than 60 years working in Thailand. For the project "**Moverity – Digital Data for Mobility**" we are currently looking for a Junior Advisor.

Junior Advisor

The ASEAN region has become one of the world's largest car and motorcycle markets as vehicle ownership grows with economic development and rising incomes. In addition, several ASEAN member states (AMS) are successfully promoting automotive industry development. Following global policy trends and based on national energy and environmental concerns, AMS have started to introduce policies to promote improvements in the energy efficiency of vehicles. In order to design and evaluate sustainable transport policies, sound data needs to be collected. Key data to be collected will include the number of vehicles, distance, and fuel use. The number of vehicles and distance tend to be reasonably well-covered by regular public data collection. However, data on fuel consumption is scant at best and usually only covers so-called "stated fuel economy" provided by car manufactures and not real-world fuel economy (FE).

Against this background, GIZ and Toyota, in 2018, together have started to develop a web portal for data collection on crowd-sourced real-world fuel consumption of cars: <https://mymoverity.com/> as well as a chatbot on Facebook messenger. Toyota and GIZ are currently working on the finalization of the project, including the following tasks:

1. Improvements and additional language versions of the chatbot and website
2. Development of a mobile app
3. Dissemination and outreach
4. Sustainable funding

Once finalized, Moverity aims to be a practical solution that allows car owners across Southeast Asia to monitor and manage their fuel costs and receive eco-driving tips. It further provides a transparent information source for potential car buyers that seek to buy a vehicle with low fuel consumption.

For the coordination of the outstanding tasks, we are looking for a Junior Advisor:

Responsibilities:

With a focus on coordination and communication, the **Junior Advisor** will support all activities in accordance with the work plan of the programme. He / She will

- coordinate and review of deliverables of consulting contracts and contracts with IT developers
- support in the acquisition of datasets for different car models from different ASEAN countries
- support the planning, implementation and documentation of meetings, workshops, and regional events in the context of the project
- support the elaboration of a communication strategy and engage in outreach and promotion activities
- support project management and monitoring including the recording and documentation of results and the elaboration of project reports;

What we are looking for:

- A highly motivated candidate with experience and skills in communication and outreach
- Affinity for social media and digital topics
- Independent and solution-oriented work style
- Experience in project management or research in an area related to the project's requirements is desirable
- Academic background or knowledge of sustainable transport and particularly fuel efficiency or car technology is advantageous
- Excellent command of Thai and English in writing and speaking
- Excellent command of MS-Office
