Intern with a focus on agricultural database system

The TGCP-Agriculture project commenced in January 2018 and will run until April 2022. The project aims at supporting national and subnational implementation of Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs) in Thailand. TGCP-Agriculture supports the rice sector in integrating climate adaptation and mitigation in the rice sector policy and strategies, promote and enhance capacity of agriculture officers and farmers in sustainable rice cultivation with focus given to low-emission practices, and introduce a Measurement, Reporting and Verification (MRV) system in the rice sector that is linked to improved farming practices with benefits in mitigation of and adaptation to climate change.

In addition to the TGCP-Agriculture project, GIZ and Rice Department are also initiating other rice sector support projects in which coordination and collaboration between the two agencies and other relevant stakeholders is needed. To support the project as well as other activities implemented in collaboration with the Thai Rice Department, we are looking for an intern with the following responsibilities and qualifications.

Responsibilities and Tasks:

- Collect and compile relevant data and information (i.e., rice farming activity data, GHG Emission data etc.) to support implementation of the project
- Support the project team in facilitating the data entry into the farmer database, including data collection, Thai-English data translation, quality assurance and data management
- Respond to data and information requests from the project team, the Rice Department and other relevant stakeholders
- Assist in the project works to develop a Measurement, Reporting and Verification (MRV) system in the rice sector
- Support project planning, implementation, and reporting of the rice related projects
- Support coordination with the Rice Department and related stakeholders (private and other public agencies)

Qualifications:

We are looking for a candidate who preferably possesses (the equivalent of):

- Bachelor's / master's degree or being in the last third of your studies in related fields; agriculture, environmental studies, information and communications technology etc.
- Ability to travel and work independently in an international multi – cultural environment
- Excellent communication skills in Thai and English.
- Excellent management and organization skills are required;
- Excellent computer literacy; and
- Thai Nationality

The paid internship is for 4 months (with high possibility of extension to 6 months) based in GIZ Office (Agriculture and Food) at the Rice Department, starting in January 2022.
