### **Intern for Renewable Energy**

The Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) aims to support Thai green hydrogen development. The GIZ was commissioned by the Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Climate Action (BMWK) with the implementation of the international Hydrogen Ramp-up Program (H2-Uppp). The objective of the project is to seize the opportunities of green H2 and Power-to-X by aiming at identifying production and deployment opportunities, exploring pathways, and supporting the realization of Thai-German project ideas and business models. The project will therefore foster innovation, knowledge transfer and eventually support the scaling of production and use of green H2 and Power-to-X while strengthening the position of German technology providers as leading innovators in Thailand.

Although the project will first and foremost focus on market development and piloting in Thailand, the approaches and concepts developed and tested will contribute to creating blueprints for H2 market development in Southeast Asia.

#### **Tasks and responsibilities:**

The intern will carry out the following tasks:

- Assist in the preparation of documents and coordination for the procurement of goods and consultancy services in accordance with GIZ process and rules
- Assist in monitoring and updating status of on-going procurement process and consultancy contract under the project
- Assist in the implementation of project activities during the project preparatory phase such as preparing relevant documents/presentations for (online/physical) meetings, and workshops etc.
- Assist in the development of communication materials for the project such as preparing project factsheet and communication materials, preparing PowerPoint presentations, drafting articles and translation of documents.
- Other relevant tasks assigned by the project team

### Qualifications:

- Master/ Senior bachelor students in Business Administration, Public Administration, International Relations, Engineering, Management, Economics, or related field
- Technical knowledge of energy sector, and renewable energy are a plus
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Excellent command of English and Thai language (both written and spoken)
