The objective of the project is to seize the opportunities of green H2 and Power-to-X by aiming at identifying production and deployment opportunities, exploring pathways, and supporting the realization of Thai-German project ideas and business models. The project will therefore foster innovation, knowledge transfer and eventually support the scaling of production and use of green H2 and Power-to-X while strengthening the position of German technology providers as leading innovators in Thailand.

Although the project will first and foremost focus on market development and piloting in Thailand, the approaches and concepts developed and tested will contribute to creating blueprints for H2 market development in Southeast Asia.
