

Thai-German cooperation on climate change started with its first joint projects in 2008 and up until now Thailand has already taken substantial steps both in the field of climate change mitigation and adaptation. In the area of climate change policy development, GIZ works closely with the Office of Natural Resources and Environmental Policy and Planning (ONEP) as the main political partner and in cooperation with other key line agencies, national and international experts on improving the climate policy environment and enabling the implementation of these policies at the national and subnational level. Recently, we have expanded this cooperation with ONEP to the field of biodiversity conservation and management. To ensure efficient project implementation in this multi-stakeholder environment in line with international standards, supporting the implementation of key global agreements, particularly the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), the Paris Agreement, the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD) and the United Nations 2030 Agenda, we as integrated team of national and international climate and environmental policy analysts and political scientists, under the Climate, Coastal and Marine Biodiversity (CCMB) project, are now seeking for an interested candidate to complement our team and provide key supporting functions of project implementation.

**To exercise the Public Relations and Communication Specialist's responsibilities, the following tasks are foreseen:**

- Develop PR and communication strategies and campaigns to increase visibility of project activities and outcomes
- Build positive relationships with political partners, stakeholders, media, and the public
- Edit and maintain up-to-date online and offline promotional materials and publications (newsletters, brochures, factsheets, booklets, videos, social media posts, etc.)
- Organize PR and other awareness events and prepare keynote speeches, ensuring accurate presentation of key project-related information and climate and biodiversity topics
- Assist in preparing, executing and documenting workshops and other events together with GIZ technical advisors and partner institutions
- Prepare and distribute press releases

- Manage for professional and timely deliveries of project's communications and knowledge management tasks and products
- Manage PR and communication-related issues in close consultation with project director
- Provide research support as needed by the project director to support and/or enhance communication advice for partner institutions
- Track media coverage and follow industry trends
- Build a database of online and offline materials and publications, including project-related media database
- Prepare and submit PR reports
- Contribute to GIZ-wide communication and knowledge management
- Perform other duties and tasks at the request of management

**Qualifications:**

- Master's degree in communications, journalism, English, political science, environmental policy, environmental science, or related discipline
- At least 5 years of professional work experience in media/communications or related field, preferably internationally
- A strong writer and editor with a flair for turning technical abstract issues into simple non-technical stories for a broad audience
- Knowledge in graphic and design skills, photo-taking, video shooting and editing, website maintenance and understanding of Search Engine Optimization (SEO) are an asset.

- Excellent organizational skills and ability to manage multiple tasks
- Hands-on mentality and detail-oriented work ethics
- Able to work under time pressure by ensuring quality outputs and meeting deadlines
