Intern TGC-EMC (Renewable Energy Component)

GIZ has been tasked to develop and implement the program "Thai-German Cooperation on Energy, Mobility and Climate (TGC EMC)" by the Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Climate Action (BMWK). The project aims at accelerating Thailand's energy and transport transition toward sustainability, ensuring economic growth and compatibility with high climate ambitions.

The project will support Thailand's efforts to reach carbon neutrality by 2050. Focusing on the two most important sectors in terms of emissions, it will support the operationalisation of the power and transport transition through technology and knowledge transfer as well as policy, regulatory, and business model development support. A clear focus will be put on sector coupling to encourage the tackling of issues shared across sectors which slow the energy transition. This cross-sectoral support to implementation will also translate into city labs in which the technical, regulatory, and business support will be operationalized along with local stakeholders in an urban set up and will integrate a scaling-up plan. Finally, the project will provide significant support in the field of climate finance. The Thai Climate Finance Initiative (ThaiCl) will provide seed funding to a number of local projects along with capacity development to both the funder manager and potential recipients.

Responsibilities:

- Assist in the implementation of project activities such as preparing relevant documents/presentations for meetings, trainings, and workshops etc.
- Assist in the coordination and collaboration with project's partners.
- Assist in the monitoring and analysis of government energy policies that may be important to the project.
- Assist in the development of presentations, visualization materials, other knowledge products, and knowledgesharing activities in both Thai and English language.
- Other relevant tasks assigned by the project team

Qualifications:

Applicants are not required to have professional work experience but are encouraged to list all relevant work experiences in their application, as well as interests, skills, and knowledge. To qualify for an internship with the TGC EMC project, the following conditions should be met:

• Master/ Senior bachelor's students in Engineering, Science, Economics, Business Administration, Public Administration, International Relations, or related fields.



- Strong interest in sustainable development, climate change, renewable energy, energy transition
- Excellent command of MS Office package (Word, Excel, and PowerPoint)
- Fluency in English and Thai (written and spoken) is required.
- Good communication and social skills.

Duty station and timeframe:

The intern will be based in Bangkok and will report to the GIZ's Energy Office located at Sivatel Tower (near BTS Ploenchit). The internship duration is 3 months and can be extended to 6 months. The selected candidate is expected to start on **1 August 2023**. This position is a renumerated internship.
