The TGC EMC program supports Thailand's energy transition, emphasizing renewable energy, including biomass from agricultural residues, to address pollution and promote sustainable growth. The Biomass to Energy component targets enhancing the energy supply chain by utilizing agricultural residues, especially from sugarcane and rice aligning with national policies and supporting farmer income. GIZ collaborates with local agencies to tackle emissions, enhance agricultural practices, and implement effective management systems. Nakhon Sawan was selected as a pilot area for its significant PM2.5 pollution issues and the presence of biomass power plants that use agricultural residues.

We are seeking a motivated and dedicated Advisor to join our team in Nakhon Sawan province. This position offers a unique opportunity to contribute to a pioneering project focused on converting biomass to sustainable energy. The ideal candidate will have a passion for renewable energy and a commitment to environmental sustainability.

Main Role:

The role of the Advisor is to support the Senior Advisor in the the planning, development, and implementation of the biomass-to-energy project in Nakhon Sawan. Engage with local stakeholders, provide technical support, coordinate training sessions for local farmers and farmer groups.

Major Functions/Duties:

Under the direct supervision of the Project Manager and as a member of the project team, the Advisor will be:

- Working and collaborating directly with farmers via trainings, monitoring and implementation of activities
- Reviewing and reporting on project progress, providing translation support, and assist in project execution
- Coordinating and preparing for meetings, workshops, and training events, including handling documents and presentations
- Conducting research, in-field visits, data collection, and engaging with local stakeholders, ensuring efficient document management
- Support with external contractors and service providers, visiting project sites, liaising with stakeholders, and networking

- Networking with stakeholders from the public and private sector
- Contributing to project monitoring and evaluation, reviewing expenditures, complying with financial rules, and assisting in audits and financial reporting.
- Supporting promotional activities through stories, articles, and PR efforts.

Qualifications:

- Thai nationality only
- At least Bachelor's degree in Renewable Energy, Environmental Engineering, Agriculture, or related field
- Minimum 2-5 years of relevant working experience in renewable energy, rice or sugarcane industry, biomass power plants
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Excellent command Thai language (both written and spoken), and at least good English skills (written and spoken)

- Valid car driving license
