Topics span from energy transition, incl. renewable energies and energy efficiency to green hydrogen market ramp up as well as private sector cooperation.

The project "Thai-German Energy Dialog" based in Bangkok offers a position as **Advisor (Renewable Energy Transition - Senior Level)**, starting **15th April 2025**.

Key Tasks:

- Strategic development of project key focus areas and management of project operations.
- Manage technical and organizational tasks for the implementation of project activities and events.
- Develop and maintain a network of relevant partners in Thailand; particularly governmental bodies, ministries and agencies, private stakeholder representatives and business associations;
- Conceptualize terms of references for consulting services, studies and events, manage and steer local and international consultants and ensure quality of all related outputs.
- Advise on the policy and regulatory framework to promote energy transition, in particular on measures to increase renewable energy, energy efficiency and resilient energy infrastructure.
- Research, analyze and summarize information on Thailand's energy sector development, policies and regulations.
- Facilitate experience exchange on energy topics between German experts and relevant Thai stakeholders.
- Develop communication materials for the project such as preparing project factsheet, policy briefings and communication materials in Thai and English.
- Planning and coordination as well as monitoring and reporting of project activities.

Requirements:

- Master and/or Bachelor university degree in an area related to the project's topics, e.g. energy, energy efficiency, energy / facility management, process engineering and etc.
- At least 5 years of professional experience in energy area in particular with energy, renewable energy or public and private sector cooperation.
- Knowledge of Thai and international policies and best practices on renewable energy, energy efficiency and overall energy transition.
- Excellent organizational and project management skills. Efficient, accurate and high-quality delivery of all work-related outputs.
- High work ethics, reliability, personal integrity and motivation. The successful candidate must be able to handle multiple simultaneous assignments with competing priorities and fixed deadlines.
- Thai mother tongue and fluency in English (written and spoken).
- Excellent interpersonal, communication and networking skills. Diplomatic communication and political sensitivity required due to work in a bilateral government cooperation project of high visibility.
- Thai nationality only.
