We are looking for **an expert/consultant** to provide consultancy service **Transport Decarbonisation Pathway** for **The Thai German Cooperation on Energy, Mobility and Climate (TGC-EMC)**

Transport Decarbonisation Pathway

The Thai German Cooperation on Energy, Mobility and Climate (TGC-EMC) is a bilateral project funded by the International Climate Initiative (IKI) under the German Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Climate Action (BMWK). This 5-year initiative (2023–2027) aims to enable and empower key actors in Thailand, particularly decision-makers and technical staff from relevant ministries and agencies, to implement transformative mitigation actions across the energy, transport, and industry sectors. The project aims to support Thailand' to meet its NDC, Carbon Neutrality (2050), and Net Zero Emissions (2065) targets.

The project aims to support Office of Transport and Traffic Policy and Planning (OTP) in drafting decarbonisation pathways for the transport sector to achieve NDC targets, carbon neutrality by 2050 and net-zero emissions by 2065. This includes reviewing the current GHG emissions profile across all major transport modes (road, rail, maritime, and aviation) and assessing the progress of existing mitigation actions outlined in the NDC Action Plan for the transport sector. This assessment will help determine whether these actions are sufficient for Thailand to its climate commitments within the national timeline.

Qualifications:

The consultant is required to have the following qualifications

- 1) Education/training: university degree in Environmental Science, Engineering, Economics, or Public Policy
- 2) Language: B2-level language proficiency in English
- 3) General professional experience: 5-10 years of professional experience in the sustainable transport sector
- 4) Specific professional experience: 5-10 years in transport policy research and have a strong working relationship with OTP
- 5) Leadership/management experience: 3-5 years of management/leadership experience as project team leader or manager in a company
- 6) Development cooperation (DC) experience: 3-5 years of experience in DC projects

This will be an assignment-based contract, with a period of 9 months from 15 July 2025 to 31 March 2026 tentatively, with possibility to change period in case delay of tender process.
